The program seeks to bring together residents and fellows who have a background and interest in scientific, health services and health policy research with seasoned academic radiologists. The full day program offers health policy research curriculum, scholar presentations and focused mentoring sessions.

We invite you to nominate one resident or fellow in your department that has great potential as a future leader in radiology. The nominee will be required to prepare an abstract for a current research project for which they are the lead investigator and would be first author.

The Research Scholar Program will be held during the AUR Meeting on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at the Omni Orlando Resort at ChampionsGate in Orlando, Florida. Selected scholars will be required to register for the full four-day AUR meeting and will be required to join AUR if they are not currently a member.

Twenty travel stipends of \$1,000 will be awarded to the institutions of residents/fellows who demonstrate a commitment to scientific, health services and health policy research. Ten of the twenty scholars will be selected to present their research during the program.
