This program supports the training of managers and future managers in the only case-based course designed for academic radiology leaders. **Please note, this course is not intended for junior faculty.**

The AUR Radiology Management Award will again be presented in 2018. This award will fulfill the desire for the Program to evolve into an even more interactive educational experience, while continuing with the case-based format. The winner of the award will present his/her case during the Program. Only past participants of the Program are eligible for this award.

The 2018 AUR Radiology Management Program will be held on Tuesday, May 8 and Wednesday, May 9 during the AUR 66th Annual Meeting, at the Omni Orlando Resort at ChampionsGate in Orlando, Florida.

CME credit will be given for this program. Participants of this course will be required to register for the AUR Annual Meeting.

The Radiology Management Program is designed for approximately 30 radiologists and administrators. The limited number of participants is necessary due to the interactive nature of the teaching method. This course will focus on management and leadership including:

- Productivity Based Compensation Plan for Academic Radiologists
- Academic Radiology Expansion into Regional Practice
- Academic Radiology Departments Relationship with Industry
- Burnout
- Practice Quality Improvement
- Negotiation Skills: The Case of Financial Negotiation for Equipment Purchases

Nominations are open to individual AUR members. The Program is based primarily on the case-study method, in combination with keynote talks.
